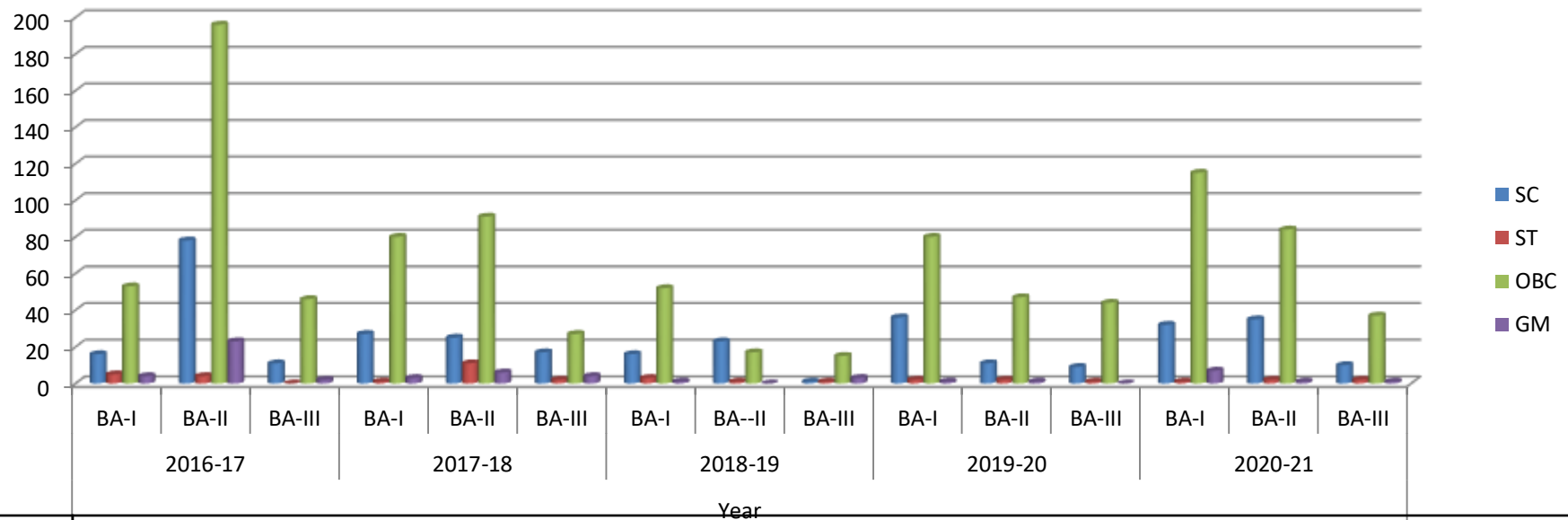

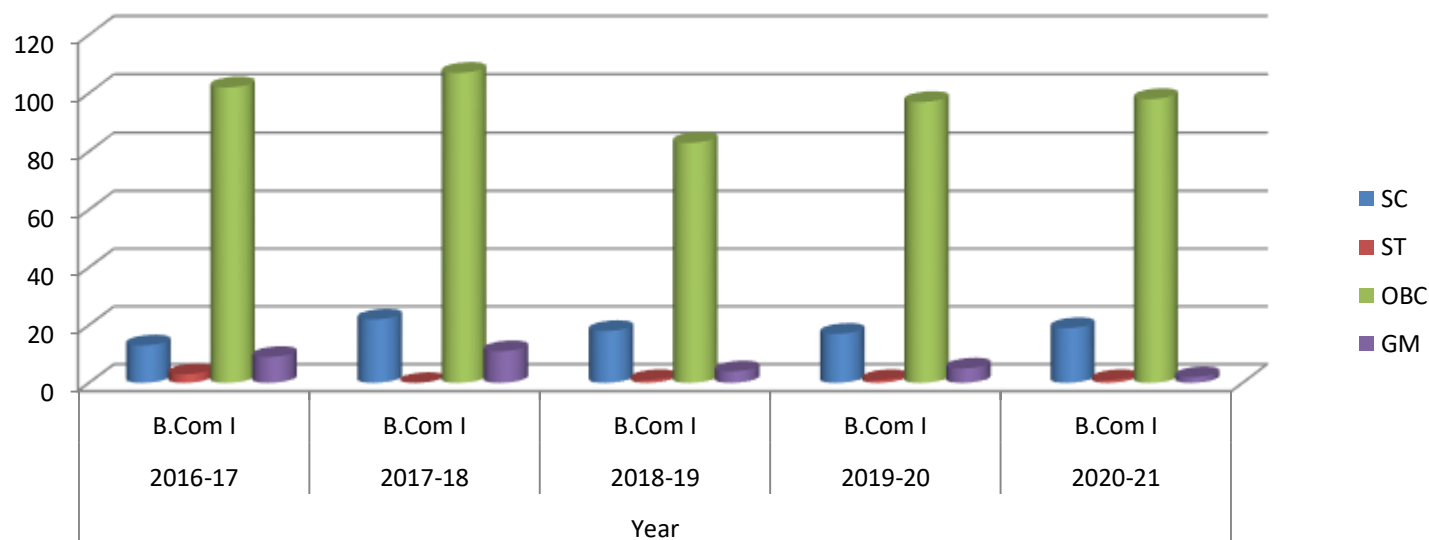

Category wise strength of the Students-B.A



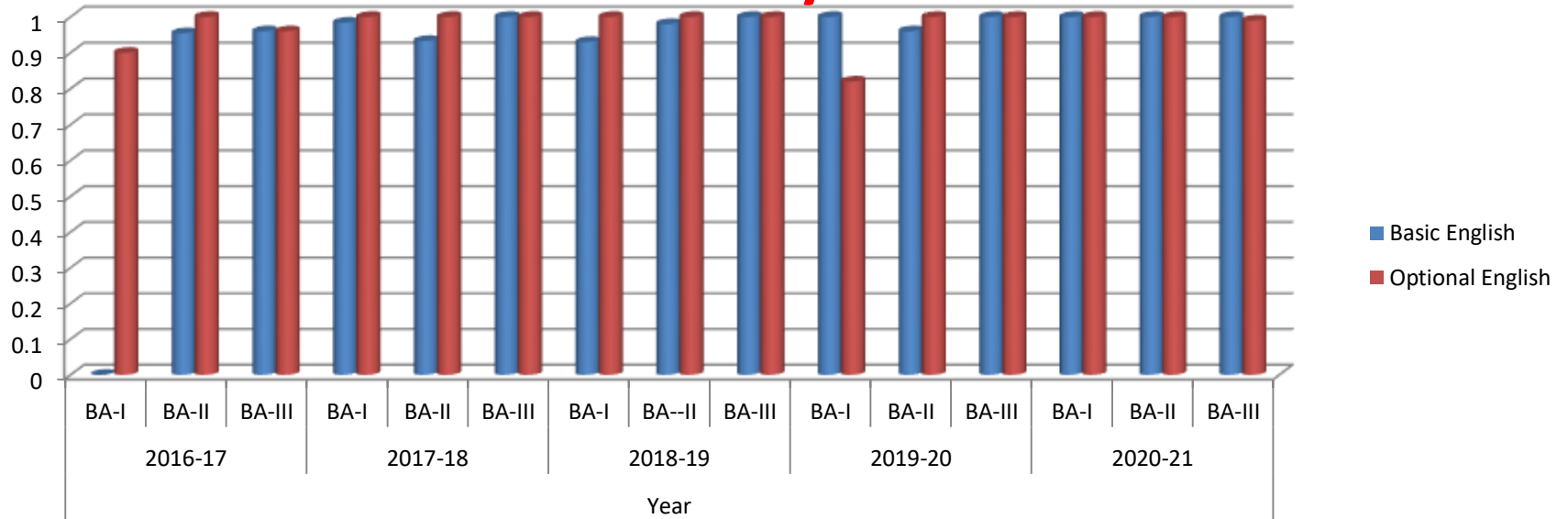

Category wise strength of the Students-B.Com



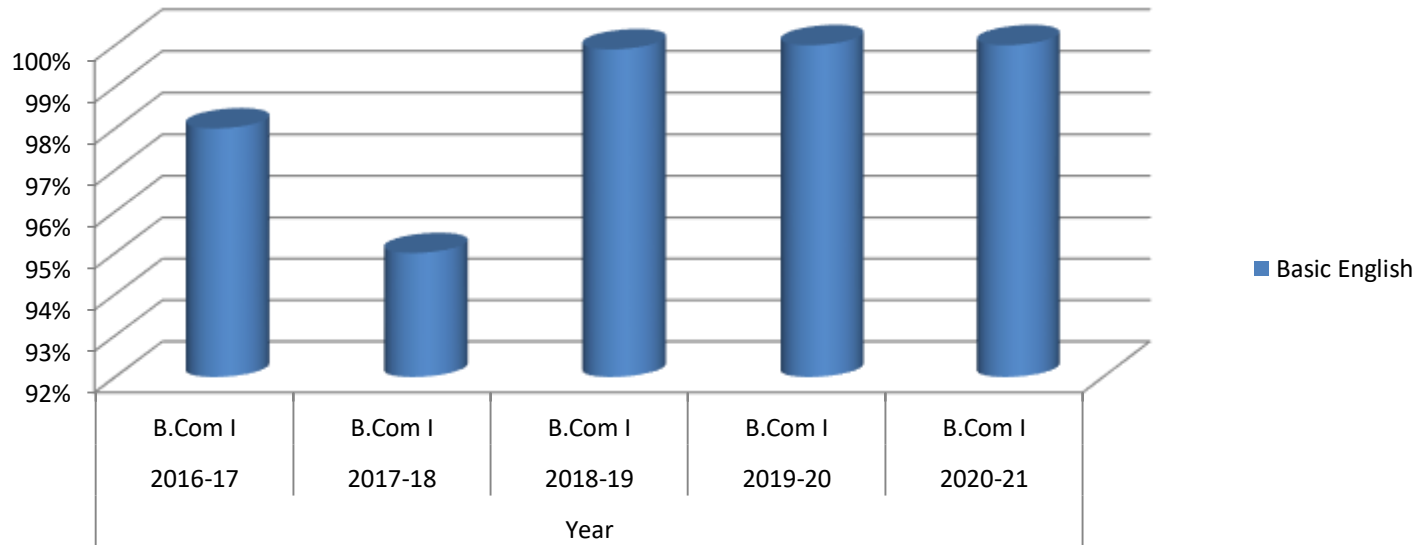
